1-21 relating to the compensation of an election judge or clerk.  
 1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
 1-23 SECTION 1. Section 32.091(b), Election Code, is amended to  
 1-24 read as follows:  
 1-25 (b) A judge or clerk may not be paid for more than two hours  
 1-26 [~~one hour~~] of work before the polls open, except for payment made  
 1-27 for work under Section 62.014(c). In a precinct in which voting  
 1-28 machines are used, a judge or clerk may not be paid for more than two  
 1-29 hours of work after the time for closing the polls or after the last  
 1-30 voter has voted, whichever is later.  
 1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
