4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 8849, Special District Local Laws Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 8849.107 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 8849.107. MITIGATION PROGRAM. (a) The district may,
8	by rule, establish a mitigation program to address excessive
9	drawdown in an aquifer or subdivision of an aquifer such that the
10	potentiometric surface is below the desired future condition or has
11	resulted in wells having become non-productive. In accordance with
12	a district rule, mitigation may take the form of:
13	1) reducing groundwater production within the
14	aquifer or subdivision of an aquifer; or
15	2) providing reimbursement for the cost of
16	repairing wells to access groundwater below the potentiometric
17	surface of the aquifer or subdivision of an aquifer.

- 18 (b) The district may fund the mitigation program utilizing
- 19 pumping fees, export fees, or any other revenue available to the
- 20 <u>district.</u>
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 8849.151, Special District Local Laws
- 22 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 8849.151. [PUMPING] FEES. (a) The district may assess
- 24 regulatory <u>production</u> [<u>pumping</u>] fees <u>pursuant to Section</u>

- 1 36.205(c), Water Code, and regulatory export fees pursuant to
- 2 <u>Section 36.122</u>, <u>Water Code</u> [for water produced in or exported from
- 3 the district].
- 4 (b) The regulatory production [pumping] fees the district
- 5 assesses for water for crop or livestock production or other
- 6 agricultural uses may not exceed 20 percent of the rate applied to
- 7 water for municipal uses.
- 8 (c) Regulatory production [pumping] fees [based on the
- 9 amount of water withdrawn from a well] may not exceed:
- 10 (1) \$1 for each acre-foot for water used to irrigate
- 11 agricultural crops; or
- 12 (2) 17 cents for each thousand gallons for water used
- 13 for any other purpose.
- 14 [(d) Combined regulatory pumping fees for production and
- 15 export of water may not exceed 17 cents for each thousand gallons
- 16 **for water used.**]
- 17 SECTION 3. Mitigation payments and fees assessed before the
- 18 effective date of this Act are ratified, confirmed, and validated
- 19 and all governmental acts and proceedings of the board of directors
- 20 that occurred before the effective date of this Act are validated
- 21 for all purposes.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
