4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 153.051(d), Occupations Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(d) The board may not set, charge, collect, receive, or
8	deposit any of the following fees in excess of:
9	(1) \$900 for a license;
10	(2) \$400 for a first registration permit;
11	(3) \$200 for a temporary license;
12	(4) \$400 for renewal of a registration permit;
13	(5) \$200 for a physician-in-training permit;
14	(6) \$600 for the processing of an application and the
15	issuance of a registration for anesthesia in an outpatient setting;
16	(7) \$200 for an endorsement to other state medical
17	boards;
18	(8) \$200 for a duplicate license;
19	(9) \$700 for a reinstated license after cancellation
20	for cause; or
21	(10) $\frac{\$5}{\$}$ [ $\frac{\$1,200}{\$}$ ] for $\frac{\$1}{\$}$ [an annual] fee under Section
22	167.011(c) for a program participant in the Texas Physician Health
23	Program, due at the time of license issuance and registration

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 167.011(c), Occupations Code, is amended
- 2 to read as follows:
- 3 (c) Each <u>license holder</u> [<u>program participant</u>] shall pay <u>the</u>
- 4 [an annual] fee required under Section 153.051(d)(10) to partially
- 5 offset the cost of participation and monitoring services.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 153.051, Occupations Code, as amended by
- 7 this Act, applies to the initial issuance of a license or the
- 8 renewal of a registration permit under Subtitle B, Title 3,
- 9 Occupations Code, on or after September 1, 2023. A license
- 10 initially issued or registration permit renewed before September 1,
- 11 2023, is governed by the law in effect immediately before the
- 12 effective date of this Act, and the former law is continued in
- 13 effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
