S.B. No. 1082

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the definition and use of the terms "male" and "female" 3 for purposes of certain government documents. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. FINDINGS. The legislature finds that: 5 6 (1) males and females possess unique immutable 7 biological differences that manifest prior to birth and increase as 8 individuals age and experience puberty; 9 (2) biological differences between the sexes mean that only females are able to get pregnant, give birth, and breastfeed 10 11 children; (3) biological differences between the sexes mean that 12 males are, on average, bigger, stronger, and faster than females; 13 14 (4) biological differences between the sexes leave females more physically vulnerable than males to specific forms of 15 16 violence, including sexual violence; females have historically suffered discrimination 17 (5) 18 in education, athletics, and employment; (6) biological differences between the sexes 19 are 20 enduring and may, in some circumstances, warrant the creation of 21 separate social, educational, athletic, or other spaces in order to 22 ensure individuals' safety and allow members of each sex to succeed 23 and thrive; (7) 24 inconsistencies in court rulings and policy

S.B. No. 1082 initiatives with regard to the definitions of "sex," "male," 1 "female," "man," and "woman" have led to endangerment of single-sex 2 spaces and resources, necessitating clarification of certain 3 terms; and 4 an individual's sex is defined as the individual's 5 (8) 6 biological sex at birth, either male or female. 7 SECTION 2. Chapter 2051, Government Code, is amended by 8 adding Subchapter G to read as follows: 9 SUBCHAPTER G. DEFINITIONS OF MALE AND FEMALE FOR CERTAIN GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS, PUBLICATIONS, AND NOTICES 10 Sec. 2051.251. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter: 11 (1) "Female" means an individual whose biological 12 reproductive system is developed to produce ova. 13 14 (2) "Governmental entity" has the meaning assigned by <u>Section 2051.04</u>1. 15 16 (3) "Male" means an individual whose biological 17 reproductive system is developed to fertilize the ova of a female. Sec. 2051.252. DEFINITIONS OF MALE AND FEMALE FOR CERTAIN 18 GOVERNMENT DOCUMENTS, PUBLICATIONS, AND NOTICES. A document, 19 policy, survey, questionnaire, report, publication, notice, or 20 other written or electronic material produced by a governmental 21 entity or official may only reference two sexes, male and female, 22 when requesting or providing information regarding a person's sex. 23 24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
