21	(10) <u>\$15</u> [\$1,200] for <u>a surcharge</u> [an annual fee]

1 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 153, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Section 153.053 to read as follows: 2

3 Sec. 153.053. SURCHARGE TO ADMINISTER TEXAS PHYSICIAN HEALTH PROGRAM. (a) The board shall collect an additional 4 5 surcharge not to exceed \$15 for each of the following fees:

(1) first registration permit; and

7

(2) renewal of a registration permit.

8 (b) The board shall deposit each surcharge collected under this section to the credit of the Texas physician health program 9 account. The Texas physician health program account is a special 10 account in the general revenue fund. Money in the special account 11 12 shall be appropriated only to the board to pay for administration of the Texas Physician Health Program under Chapter 167, including 13 paying for an initial evaluation by the program's medical director 14 or the director's designee. Money in the special account may not be 15 used to pay for program participant costs incurred for monitoring 16 17 or for a program participant's own medical costs, including any further required evaluations, primary treatment, or continuing 18 19 care.

SECTION 3. Section 167.011, Occupations Code, is repealed. 21 SECTION 4. Section 153.051, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, and Section 153.053, Occupations Code, as added by this 22 23 Act, apply to the initial issuance of a license or the renewal of a registration permit under Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code, on 24 or after September 1, 2023. A license initially issued or 25 26 registration permit renewed before September 1, 2023, is governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date of this 27

Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
