Section 48.156, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 14 Sec. 48.156. CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION REIMBURSEMENT. 15 Α school district is entitled to reimbursement for the amount of a 16 subsidy paid by the district for <u>each</u> [a student's] certification 17 18 examination under Section 29.190(a) as provided by Section 19 29.190(c). 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
