1-23 relating to authorization and reimbursement for certain
 1-24 examination fee subsidies paid for public school teachers and
 1-25 students.

1-26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-27 SECTION 1. Sections 29.190(a-1) and (b), Education Code,
 1-28 are amended to read as follows:

1-29 (a-1) A student may ~~not~~ receive more than one subsidy
 1-30 under this section.

1-31 (b) A teacher is entitled to a subsidy under this section if
 1-32 the teacher passes a certification examination related to career
 1-33 and technology education ~~[cybersecurity]~~.

1-34 SECTION 2. Section 48.156, Education Code, is amended to
 1-35 read as follows:

1-36 Sec. 48.156. CERTIFICATION EXAMINATION REIMBURSEMENT. A
 1-37 school district is entitled to reimbursement for the amount of a
 1-38 subsidy paid by the district for each ~~[a student's]~~ certification
 1-39 examination under Section 29.190(a) as provided by Section
 1-40 29.190(c).

1-41 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
