 1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to purchased power costs incurred by electric utilities.
 1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-25 SECTION 1. Section 36.205, Utilities Code, is amended by
 1-26 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
 1-27 (e) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), an electric utility may
 1-28 apply to the commission for review and approval of an agreement
 1-29 between the electric utility and another person for the purchase of
 1-30 power by the electric utility if approval by the commission is a
 1-31 pre-condition to the effectiveness of the electric utility's right
 1-32 or obligation to purchase power under the agreement. This
 1-33 subsection applies only to an agreement with a term of three years
 1-34 or more. The commission by rule shall implement this subsection
 1-35 consistent with the standards and procedures in the commission's
 1-36 rules governing contested cases on certificates of convenience and
 1-37 necessity for generating facilities adopted under Sections 37.056
 1-38 and 37.058. This subsection expires September 1, 2033.
 1-39 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
