Section 478.0053, Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 9 Sec. 478.0053. EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN 10 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENT FOR CERTAIN LARGE VENUES. Section 478.0051(b)(1) does 11 apply to an event described by Section 478.0001(3)(M) 12 not [478.0001(3)(H)]. If an endorsing municipality or endorsing county 13 requests the office to make a determination under Section 478.0102 14 15 for an event described by Section [478.0001(3)(H)], the remaining provisions of this 478.0001(3)(M) 16 17 chapter apply to that event as if the event satisfied the eligibility requirements under Section 478.0051(b)(1). 18

19 SECTION 4. To the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails 20 over another Act of the 88th Legislature, Regular Session, 2023, 21 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted 22 codes.
