## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT 2 relating to purchasing by the Department of Information Resources 3 of information technology commodity items.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 2157.068(a), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:

(a) In this section:

(1) "Commodity[, "commodity] items" means commercial 8 software, hardware, or technology services, other 9 than 10 telecommunications services, that are generally available to businesses or the public and for which the department determines 11 12 that a reasonable demand exists from a customer [two or more 13 customers], including a state agency or [agencies and] political subdivision [subdivisions] of this state, an entity [entities] 14 15 described by Subsection (j), or a [and] governmental entity [entities] of another state, that purchases [purchase] the items 16 17 through the department. The term includes seat management, through which a customer transfers its personal computer equipment and 18 service responsibilities to a private vendor to manage the personal 19 computing needs for each desktop of the customer, including all 20 necessary hardware, software, and support services. 21

(2) "Technology services" means services, regardless
of how the fees for those services are generally charged, that:
(A) relate to the development, configuration,

1	review,	assessment,	acquisition,	implementation,	or	maintenance	of

- 2 information technology hardware, software, or services; or
- 3 (B) consist of other routine technology services
- 4 not described by Paragraph (A).
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
