5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 38.041 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.041. ACCOMMODATIONS FOR LACTATING STUDENTS. The
8	board of trustees of each school district, the governing boards of
9	the Texas School for the Blind and Visually Impaired and the Texas
10	School for the Deaf, and the governing body of each open-enrollment
11	charter school shall provide reasonable accommodations to a
12	lactating student enrolled at the middle or high school level to
13	enable the student to:
14	(1) express breast milk;
15	(2) breast-feed an infant child; and

- (3) address other needs related to breast-feeding. 16
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 school year. 18
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 19
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 20
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 21
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
