- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 27.036, Water Code, as added by Chapter
- 6 921 (H.B. 1867), Acts of the 69th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 7 1985, is amended to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 27.036. JURISDICTION OVER BRINE MINING. (a) In this
- 9 section:
- 10 (1) "Brine mining" means the production of brine,
- 11 including naturally occurring brine and brine extracted by the
- 12 solution of a subsurface salt formation, for the purpose of
- 13 extracting from a subsurface formation elements, salts, or other
- 14 useful substances, not including:
- 15 (A) oil, gas, or any product of oil or gas as
- 16 defined by Section 85.001, Natural Resources Code; or
- 17 <u>(B) fluid oil and gas waste, as defined by</u>
- 18 <u>Section 122.001, Natural Resources Code.</u>
- 19 (2) "Class V brine injection well" means a well that
- 20 injects spent, naturally occurring brine produced by a brine mining
- 21 operation into the same formation from which it was withdrawn after
- 22 extraction of elements, salts, or other useful substances,
- 23 including halogens or halogen salts.
- 24 (b) The railroad commission has jurisdiction over brine

- 1 mining and may issue permits for brine production wells and
- 2 injection wells used for brine mining.
- 3 (c) [<del>(b)</del>] A person may not begin to drill an injection well
- 4 to be used for brine mining unless that person has a valid permit
- 5 for the well issued by the railroad commission under this chapter.
- 6  $\underline{\text{(d)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(e)}}{\text{)}}$ ] The railroad commission shall adopt rules that
- 7 are necessary to administer and regulate brine mining.
- 8  $\underline{\text{(e)}}$  [ $\frac{\text{(d)}}{\text{)}}$ ] For purposes of regulation by the railroad
- 9 commission, an injection well for brine mining of brine extracted
- 10 by the solution of a subsurface salt formation is designated as a
- 11 Class III well under the underground injection control program
- 12 administered by the railroad commission.
- 13 (f) For purposes of regulation by the railroad commission, a
- 14 Class V brine injection well is designated as a Class V well under
- 15 the underground injection control program administered by the
- 16 <u>railroad commission</u>.
- 17 (g) If rules or regulations adopted to govern Class V brine
- 18 injection wells under the federal Safe Drinking Water Act (42
- 19 U.S.C. Section 300f et seq.) or another federal statute allow this
- 20 state to seek primary enforcement authority under the underground
- 21 injection control program, the railroad commission shall seek
- 22 primacy to administer and enforce the program for Class V brine
- 23 <u>injection wells in this state.</u>
- 24 (h) On delegation to the railroad commission of primary
- 25 enforcement authority in this state over Class V brine injection
- 26 wells, a person may not begin to drill a Class V brine injection
- 27 well unless that person has a valid permit for the well issued by

- 1 the railroad commission under this chapter.
- 2 [(e) This section takes effect September 1, 1985.
- 3 [(f) This section does not invalidate any permit for an
- 4 injection well used for brine mining that was issued by the Texas
- 5 Water Commission before the effective date of this section. Within
- 6 90 days after the effective date of this section, the Railroad
- 7 Commission of Texas shall issue a substitute permit under the name
- 8 and authority of the railroad commission to each person who on the
- 9 effective date of this section holds a valid permit issued by the
- 10 Texas Water Commission for an injection well used for brine mining.
- 11 [(g) Application for injection well permits covering brine
- 12 mining submitted to the Texas Water Commission before the effective
- 13 date of this section for which permits have not been issued by the
- 14 commission shall be transmitted to the railroad commission.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 27.036, Water Code, as added by Chapter
- 16 795 (S.B. 249), Acts of the 69th Legislature, Regular Session,
- 17 1985, is repealed.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 22 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
