5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 8, Local Government Code, is
7	amended by adding Chapter 255 to read as follows:

CHAPTER 255. CONVERSION OF PROPERTY FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES 8

- Sec. 255.001. SPECIAL HEARING AND NOTICE REQUIREMENTS FOR 9 10 CONVERSION OF PROPERTY TO HOUSE HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (e), a municipality's governing body may 11 12 not approve the conversion of a property under the municipality's 13 control to provide housing to homeless individuals unless the governing body holds a public hearing not less than 90 days before 14 15 the municipality begins the conversion. The governing body must hold the hearing at a location within a one-mile radius of the 16 17 property.
- (b) Not later than 36 hours before a public hearing required 18 under Subsection (a) is held, a municipality's governing body must 19 provide notice of the hearing by mail to each residence and business 20 located within a one-mile radius of the property described by that 21 22 subsection.
- 23 (c) If a municipality's governing body fails to comply with 24 this section, an individual who is entitled to notice under

- 1 Subsection (b) may bring an action for injunctive relief in a
- 2 district court in the county in which the property described by
- 3 Subsection (a) is located to prevent the conversion of the
- 4 property.
- 5 (d) In the event of a conflict between this chapter and a
- 6 provision in a municipality's charter relating to the conversion or
- 7 notice of the conversion of a property described by Subsection (a),
- 8 this chapter controls.
- 9 (e) This section does not apply to the conversion of a
- 10 property to provide temporary shelter or housing during a natural
- 11 disaster, declared state of emergency, or other life-threatening
- 12 public emergency.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 255, Local Government Code, as added by
- 14 this Act, applies only to the conversion of property described by
- 15 Section 255.001(a), Local Government Code, as added by this Act,
- 16 that is set to begin on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
