A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the powers of the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District No. 110; providing authority to impose a fee 3 and impose fines and penalties. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws 6 7 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7938 to read as follows: CHAPTER 7938. HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT 8 9 NO. 110 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS 10 Sec. 7938.0101. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district" 11 12 means the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District 13 No. 110. 14 SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES Sec. 7938.0201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES 15 OF 16 COMPLIANCE FOR STORMWATER DETENTION FACILITIES. (a) The district may implement a program to require and issue an annual written 17 certificate of compliance to the owner or operator of a stormwater 18 detention facility within the boundaries of the district to ensure 19 that each stormwater detention facility is operating to abate 20 flooding as designed and approved by the applicable regulatory 21 22 authority. 23 (b) The district may assess reasonable charges and fees for 24 the implementation, administration, and enforcement of this

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1 section.

2 (c) The district may impose a fine or penalty on the owner or 3 operator of a stormwater detention facility for the failure to hold 4 a certificate of compliance as required by the district under this 5 section.

6 SECTION 2. The Harris County Water Control and Improvement 7 District No. 110 retains all the rights, powers, privileges, 8 authority, duties, and functions that it had before the effective 9 date of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all 11 governmental acts and proceedings of the Harris County Water 12 Control and Improvement District No. 110 that were taken before the 13 effective date of this Act.

14 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the 15 effective date of this Act:

16 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation 17 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court 18 judgment; or

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(2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.

20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
