 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to the powers of the Harris County Water Control and
 1-20 Improvement District No. 110; providing authority to impose a fee
 1-21 and impose fines and penalties.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subtitle F, Title 6, Special District Local Laws
 1-24 Code, is amended by adding Chapter 7938 to read as follows:

1-25 CHAPTER 7938. HARRIS COUNTY WATER CONTROL AND IMPROVEMENT

1-26 DISTRICT NO. 110

1-27 SUBCHAPTER A. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1-28 Sec. 7938.0101. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "district"
 1-29 means the Harris County Water Control and Improvement District
 1-30 No. 110.

1-31 SUBCHAPTER B. POWERS AND DUTIES

1-32 Sec. 7938.0201. AUTHORITY TO ISSUE CERTIFICATES OF
 1-33 COMPLIANCE FOR STORMWATER DETENTION FACILITIES. (a) The district
 1-34 may implement a program to require and issue an annual written
 1-35 certificate of compliance to the owner or operator of a stormwater
 1-36 detention facility within the boundaries of the district to ensure
 1-37 that each stormwater detention facility is operating to abate
 1-38 flooding as designed and approved by the applicable regulatory
 1-39 authority.

1-40 (b) The district may assess reasonable charges and fees for
 1-41 the implementation, administration, and enforcement of this
 1-42 section.

1-43 (c) The district may impose a fine or penalty on the owner or
 1-44 operator of a stormwater detention facility for the failure to hold
 1-45 a certificate of compliance as required by the district under this
 1-46 section.

1-47 SECTION 2. The Harris County Water Control and Improvement
 1-48 District No. 110 retains all the rights, powers, privileges,
 1-49 authority, duties, and functions that it had before the effective
 1-50 date of this Act.

1-51 SECTION 3. (a) The legislature validates and confirms all
 1-52 governmental acts and proceedings of the Harris County Water
 1-53 Control and Improvement District No. 110 that were taken before the
 1-54 effective date of this Act.

1-55 (b) This section does not apply to any matter that on the
 1-56 effective date of this Act:

1-57 (1) is involved in litigation if the litigation
 1-58 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final court
 1-59 judgment; or

1-60 (2) has been held invalid by a final court judgment.

1-61 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

2-1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-4 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
