2	relating to the text of ballot propositions that increase taxes.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 52.072(e), Election Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	(e) In addition to any other requirement imposed by law for
7	a proposition, including a provision prescribing the proposition
8	language, a proposition submitted to the voters for approval of the
9	imposition, increase, or reduction of a tax shall, except as
10	otherwise required by this subsection, be printed in mixed-case
11	typewritten letters and [specifically state], as applicable:
12	(1) with respect to a proposition that only seeks
13	voter approval of the imposition or increase of a tax <u>:</u>
14	(A) state $[\tau]$ the amount of or maximum tax rate of
15	the tax or tax increase for which approval is sought; and
16	(B) include, in capital typewritten letters of
17	the same font size as the rest of the proposition, the statement
18	"THIS IS A TAX INCREASE"; or
19	(2) with respect to a proposition that only seeks
20	voter approval of the reduction of a tax, state the amount of tax
21	rate reduction or the tax rate for which approval is sought.
22	SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
23	an election ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
24	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
