16	(b) If an educator preparation program has already been

- 12 (e) This section expires November 1, 2025.
- 13 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, each executive director of a regional education
- 15 service center shall appoint the members of the center's regional
- 16 teacher shortage evaluation committee, as required by Section
- 17 8.063, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
