BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 92.0563(e), Property Code, is amended to 1-20 read as follows:

1-21 (e) A justice court may not award a judgment under this 1-22 1-23 section, including an order of repair, that [\$10,000], excluding interest and costs of court. exceeds <u>\$20,000</u>

1-24 SECTION 2. Section 92.0563(e), Property Code, as amended by 1-25 this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of this Act.
