## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to the issuance of disabled parking placards to certain 3 day activity and health services facilities that transport persons 4 with a disability.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 681.0032, Transportation Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 681.0032. ISSUANCE OF DISABLED PARKING PLACARDS TO 9 CERTAIN INSTITUTIONS. (a) The department shall provide for the 10 issuance of disabled parking placards described by Section 681.002 11 for a van or bus operated by:

12 (1) an institution, facility, or residential 13 retirement community for the elderly in which a person <u>eligible for</u> 14 <u>a license plate under</u> [described by] Section <u>504.201</u> [504.201(a)] 15 resides, including an institution licensed under Chapter 242, 16 Health and Safety Code, and a facility licensed under Chapter 246 or 17 247 of that code; or

18 (2) a day activity and health services facility 19 licensed under Chapter 103, Human Resources Code, that provides 20 services to a person eligible for a license plate under Section 21 504.201.

(b) The application for a disabled parking placard must be made in the manner provided by Section 681.003(b) and be accompanied by a written statement signed by the administrator or

1 manager of, as applicable:

institution, facility, 2 (1) the retirement or described by Subsection (a)(1) certifying to the 3 community department that the institution, facility, or retirement community 4 5 regularly transports, as a part of the services that the institution, facility, or retirement community provides, one or 6 more persons eligible for a license plate under [described by] 7 Section 504.201 [504.201(a)] who reside in the institution, 8 facility, or retirement community; or 9

10 (2) the facility described by Subsection (a)(2) 11 certifying to the department that the facility regularly 12 transports, as a part of the services that the facility provides, 13 one or more persons eligible for a license plate under Section 14 <u>504.201</u>.

(c) The department shall determine the eligibility of <u>an</u>
[the] institution, facility, or retirement community <u>for a disabled</u>
<u>parking placard based</u> on the evidence the applicant provides.
