- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "commission" means
- 7 the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality.
- 8 SECTION 2. STUDY ON EFFECTS OF INSTALLATION, OPERATION,
- 9 REMOVAL, AND DISPOSAL OF CERTAIN EQUIPMENT. (a) The commission
- 10 shall conduct a study on the current and potential effects of the
- 11 installation, operation, removal, and disposal of solar, wind
- 12 turbine, and energy storage equipment on the environment and
- 13 watersheds.
- 14 (b) In conducting the study under this section, the
- 15 commission shall consult with:
- 16 (1) the Department of Agriculture;
- 17 (2) the Texas A&M Forest Service;
- 18 (3) the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service;
- 19 (4) the Texas A&M Engineering Extension Service;
- 20 (5) groundwater conservation districts; and
- 21 (6) river authorities.
- (c) The commission may enter into a memorandum of
- 23 understanding with a university or foundation to assist with the
- 24 study.

- 1 (d) Not later than December 1, 2024, the commission shall
- 2 submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, and speaker of the
- 3 house of representatives a report that includes the findings of the
- 4 study conducted under this section.
- 5 SECTION 3. EXPIRATION. This Act expires January 1, 2025.
- 6 SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect
- 7 immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members
- 8 elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas
- 9 Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for
- 10 immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
