3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1.0n the effective date of this Act, the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall recompute the annuities of persons 6 who retired before September 1, 2019, as if the retiree's salary on the date of retirement was that of a judge or justice who has eight 7 8 years and 1 day of service as of September 1, 2019 and is of the same classification as the last court to which the retiree was elected or 9 appointed. On the effective date of this Act, the retirement system 10 shall also recompute the annuities of beneficiaries receiving an 11 annuity that became payable before that date under Sections 839.301 13 or 839.302, Government Code, in the same manner.

SECTION 2. In the event the 88th Legislature 14 15 legislation increasing the state salary of district or appellate judges or justices or authorizes a state salary increase for 16 17 district or appellate judges or justices in the Appropriations Act, on the effective date of the salary increase, 18 the Employees Retirement System of Texas shall recompute the 19 annuities of persons who retired before the effective date of the 20 21 salary increase under Sections 839.102 or 839.103, Government Code, 22 as if the retiree's salary on the date of retirement was that of a judge or justice who has eight years and 1 day of service and is of 23 24 the same classification as the last court to which the retiree was

- 1 elected or appointed. On the effective date of a state salary
- 2 increase described by this Act, the retirement system shall also
- 3 recompute the annuities of beneficiaries receiving an annuity that
- 4 became payable before that date under Sections 839.301 or 839.302,
