Section 156.001, Occupations Code, is amended by 4 5 adding Subsection (e-1) to read as follows: 6 (e-1) In addition to the information required by Subsection (c), a license holder shall submit to the board with the 7 registration permit renewal application a statement on a form 8 9 prescribed by the board that: (1) any delegation by the license holder of a medical 10 act to a health care provider who is not a physician has been in 11 accordance with applicable law, including the supervision required 12 by that law; and 13 14 (2) for any prescriptive authority agreement into which the license holder has entered with an advanced practice 15 16 registered nurse or physician assistant, the agreement is in accordance with applicable law and the license holder has 17 supervised each advanced practice registered nurse and physician 18 assistant as required by the agreement. 19 SECTION 2. Section 156.001(e-1), Occupations Code, as added 20 by this Act, applies only to an application for renewal of a

by this Act, applies only to an application for renewal of a registration permit under Subtitle B, Title 3, Occupations Code, that is submitted on or after December 1, 2023. An application for renewal submitted before December 1, 2023, is governed by the law in

S.B. No. 1360 1 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the 2 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

3 SECTION 3. Not later than December 1, 2023, the Texas 4 Medical Board shall prescribe the form required by Section 5 156.001(e-1), Occupations Code, as added by this Act.

6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
