A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the unlawful production or distribution of sexually explicit videos using deep fake technology; creating a criminal 1-17 1**-**18 1-19 offense.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 21, Penal Code, is amended by adding Section 21.165 to read as follows:
