 1-20 AN ACT

1-21 relating to information contained in the annual financial audit of
 1-22 certain regional transportation authorities.

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Subchapter J, Chapter 452, Transportation Code,
 1-25 is amended by adding Section 452.453 to read as follows:

1-26 Sec. 452.453. DISAGGREGATION OF EXPENDITURES: CERTAIN
 1-27 AUTHORITIES. The subregional board of an authority consisting of
 1-28 one subregion governed by a subregional board created under
 1-29 Subchapter O shall disaggregate expenditures by member
 1-30 municipality in an annual financial report using a uniform
 1-31 methodology that is proposed by the authority, provided to the
 1-32 board, and approved by resolution of a simple majority of the member
 1-33 municipalities' governing bodies. On request of a simple majority
 1-34 of the member municipalities' governing bodies, the authority shall
 1-35 propose a new methodology for disaggregating expenditures by member
 1-36 municipality under this section.

1-37 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-38 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-39 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-40 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-41 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
