- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Title 7, Government Code, is amended by adding
- 7 Chapter 794 to read as follows:
- 8 CHAPTER 794. INTERSTATE COMPACT FOR BORDER SECURITY
- 9 Sec. 794.001. AUTHORITY TO DEVELOP AND EXECUTE COMPACT. On
- 10 behalf of this state, the governor may develop and execute an
- 11 interstate compact for border security among interested states.
- 12 Sec. 794.002. CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL NOT REQUIRED. (a) It
- 13 is the intent of the legislature that the compact developed and
- 14 executed under this chapter not require congressional approval.
- 15 (b) The compact may not increase the political power of the
- 16 compacting states in relation to the federal government.
- 17 Sec. 794.003. INTERSTATE COMPACT PROVISIONS. The compact
- 18 authorized by this chapter must provide for joint action among
- 19 compacting states on matters that include:
- 20 (1) sharing law enforcement intelligence on illegal
- 21 <u>activity occurring at the border with Mexico;</u>
- 22 (2) sharing state resources in order to build a
- 23 physical barrier, a comprehensive technological surveillance
- 24 system, or both, on state land to deter or detect illegal activity

- 1 occurring at the border with Mexico; and
- 2 (3) sharing other law enforcement resources to ensure
- 3 the protection of personnel and property.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
