## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to public school library materials and certain
3	performances at public school facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Sections 33.023, 33.024, and 33.025 to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 33.023. PROHIBITED SCHOOL LIBRARY MATERIALS AND
9	CERTAIN PERFORMANCES; PARENTAL RIGHTS REGARDING SCHOOL LIBRARY
10	MATERIALS. (a) A school district may not include in the catalog of
11	a school library of the district a book, magazine, or publication
12	<pre>that contains:</pre>
13	(1) a depiction or description of:
14	(A) pederasty;
15	(B) pedophilia;
16	(C) any type of romantic or sexual attraction
17	between an adult and a minor;
18	(D) masturbation, including mutual masturbation;
19	(E) sadomasochism;
20	(F) bestiality;
21	(G) sodomy;
22	(H) fellatio;
23	(I) any type of romantic or sexual attraction
24	between individuals of the same sex;

1	(J) transvestism;
2	(K) gender dysphoria;
3	(L) transgenderism;
4	(M) sexual intercourse; or
5	(2) a referral to a website or material that contains
6	a depiction or description of a topic described by Subdivision (1).
7	(b) A school district may not:
8	(1) host an obscene sexually oriented performance or
9	another performance in which a performer:
10	(A) is nude, as defined by Section 102.051,
11	Business & Commerce Code, or uses fake breasts or a fake
12	penis in a manner that simulates a nude performer; and
13	(B) performs or simulates a sexual act; and
14	(C) is obscene; or
15	(2) allow a person wearing drag attire or other
16	clothing, makeup, or physical markers associated with a sexually
17	oriented performance to read or perform to minors in any district
18	<pre>facility.</pre>
19	(c) On the request of a student's parent or legal guardian,
20	a school district shall disclose to the parent or legal guardian the
21	title of each material that the student has checked out from the
22	catalog of a school library of the district.
23	(d) This subsection does not preclude or limit:
24	(1) the enforcement of any other law or regulation
25	regarding conduct that is independently prohibited by the other
26	law or regulation and that would remain prohibited by the other law
27	or regulation in the absence of this section;

- 1 (2) the ability of a state officer or state agency to
- 2 inform others regarding the prohibitions and duties under this
- 3 section and the consequences under Sections 33.024 and 33.025 for
- 4 violating this section; or
- 5 (3) the authority of the attorney general to defend
- 6 the constitutionality of this section.
- 7 Sec. 33.024. PURCHASE OF LIBRARY MATERIALS FROM CERTAIN
- 8 VENDORS PROHIBITED. (a) <u>If a school\_district or\_open-enrollment</u>
- 9 charter school determines that a material in the catalog of a
- 10 school library of the district or school is in violation of Sec.
- 11 33.023, the district or school shall report to the agency as soon
- 12 as practicable the material and the vendor from which the district
- 13 or school purchased the material.
- (b) The agency shall maintain on the agency's Internet
- 15 website a list of vendors reported to the agency under Subsection
- 16 (a). The agency shall update the list not later than the 30th day
- 17 <u>after the date the agency receives a report under Subsection (a).</u>
- 18 (c) A school district or open-enrollment charter school may
- 19 not purchase materials from a vendor on the list described by
- 20 Subsection (b).
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 22 school year.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
