- 2 relating to access by the Texas Education Agency and private
- 3 schools to certain criminal history records.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.0825(b), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) The agency shall subscribe to the criminal history
- 8 clearinghouse as provided by Section 411.0845, Government Code, and
- 9 may obtain from any law enforcement or criminal justice agency all
- 10 criminal history record information and all records contained in
- 11 any closed criminal investigation file that relate to a specific
- 12 applicant for employment or current or former employee of a school
- 13 district, district of innovation, open-enrollment charter school,
- 14 other charter entity, private school that is accredited by an
- 15 accrediting agency that is a member of the Texas Private School
- 16 Accreditation Commission, regional education service center, or
- 17 shared services arrangement.
- 18 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 22, Education Code, is
- 19 amended by adding Section 22.08361 to read as follows:
- 20 <u>Sec. 22.08361. NATIONAL CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD</u>
- 21 INFORMATION REVIEW OF CERTAIN PRIVATE SCHOOL EMPLOYEES. (a) In
- 22 this section, "qualified private school" has the meaning assigned
- 23 by Section 411.0972, Government Code.
- 24 (b) This section applies to a person who is an employee of or

- 1 an applicant for employment at a qualified private school.
- 2 (c) A qualified private school may require a person to whom
- 3 this section applies to submit to a national criminal history
- 4 record information review under this section before being employed
- 5 by the school.
- 6 (d) Before or immediately after securing the services of a
- 7 person to whom this section applies, a qualified private school may
- 8 submit or require the person to whom this section applies to submit
- 9 to the department information that is required by the department
- 10 for obtaining national criminal history record information, which
- 11 may include fingerprints and photographs.
- (e) On receipt of the information under Subsection (c), the
- 13 department shall obtain the person's national criminal history
- 14 record information and report the results through the criminal
- 15 history clearinghouse as provided by Section 411.0845, Government
- 16 <u>Code</u>.
- 17 (f) Each qualified private school may obtain all criminal
- 18 history record information that relates to a person to whom this
- 19 section applies through the criminal history clearinghouse as
- 20 provided by Section 411.0845, Government Code, and may subscribe to
- 21 the criminal history record information of the person.
- 22 (g) A qualified private school may require a person to pay
- 23 any fees related to obtaining criminal history record information
- 24 under this section.
- 25 (h) If a qualified private school requires a person to whom
- 26 this section applies to submit to a national criminal history
- 27 record information review, the school shall provide the agency with

- 1 the name and information described by Subsection (d). The agency
- 2 shall facilitate the submission of information to the department to
- 3 allow the school to obtain all criminal history record information
- 4 that relates to the person to whom this section applies through the
- 5 criminal history clearinghouse as provided by Section 411.0845,
- 6 Government Code.
- 7 (i) The department, in coordination with the commissioner,
- 8 may adopt rules as necessary to implement this section.
- 9 SECTION 3. Subchapter F, Chapter 411, Government Code, is
- 10 amended by adding Section 411.0972 to read as follows:
- Sec. 411.0972. ACCESS TO CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD
- 12 INFORMATION: QUALIFIED PRIVATE SCHOOLS. (a) In this section,
- 13 "qualified private school" means a school that:
- 14 (1) offers a course of instruction for students in
- 15 this state in one or more grades from prekindergarten through grade
- 16 <u>12;</u>
- 17 (2) is accredited by an organization recognized by the
- 18 Texas Education Agency or the Texas Private School Accreditation
- 19 Commission; and
- 20 (3) is determined to be eligible by the department
- 21 under Subsection (b).
- (b) On request by a private school, the department shall
- 23 determine whether the school is eligible under the National Child
- 24 Protection Act of 1993 (34 U.S.C. Section 40102) to obtain criminal
- 25 history record information that relates to an employee or an
- 26 applicant for employment.
- 27 (c) A qualified private school may obtain state criminal

- 1 history record information from the department.
- 2 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (f), criminal history
- 3 record information obtained by a qualified private school in the
- 4 <u>original form or any subsequent form:</u>
- 5 (1) may not be released to any person except the person
- 6 who is the subject of the information;
- 7 (2) is not subject to disclosure as provided by
- 8 Chapter 552; and
- 9 <u>(3) shall be destroyed by the school after the</u>
- 10 information is used for the authorized purpose.
- 11 (e) A qualified private school may obtain criminal history
- 12 record information from the Federal Bureau of Investigation
- 13 identification division in accordance with Section 411.087.
- 14 (f) Criminal history record information obtained from the
- 15 Federal Bureau of Investigation may not be released or disclosed
- 16 <u>except on court order.</u>
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
