## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to active shooter training for peace officers. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 1701.253, Occupations Code, is amended 5 by adding Subsection (q) to read as follows: 6 (q) As part of the minimum curriculum requirements, the commission shall require an officer to complete a training program 7 of not less than 16 hours on responding to an active shooter as 8

- 9 provided by the Advanced Law Enforcement Rapid Response Training 10 Center at Texas State University--San Marcos, or a similar
- 11 <u>organization approved by the commission. An officer shall complete</u>
- 12 the program not later than the last day of the first full continuing
- 13 <u>education training period that begins on or after the date the</u>
- officer is licensed under this chapter unless the officer completes
- 15 the program as part of the officer's basic training course.
- 16 Completion of a training program under this subsection satisfies
- 17 any other requirement for the officer to complete a training
- 18 program on responding to active shooters, including under Section
- 19 <u>37.0812(a)</u>, Education Code.
- 20 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement shall adopt
- 22 rules to implement Section 1701.253(q), Occupations Code, as added
- 23 by this Act.
- SECTION 3. The minimum curriculum requirements under

- 1 Section 1701.253(q), Occupations Code, as added by this Act, apply
- 2 only to an officer who first begins to satisfy those requirements on
- 3 or after January 1, 2024.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
