Section 814.109, Government Code, is repealed. 5 6 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 7 814.109, Government Code, applies only to an individual who retires on or after the effective date of this Act. An individual who 8 retires before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 9 in effect immediately before that date, and the former law is 10 continued in effect for that purpose. 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 12 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 14 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 16
