## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

## AN ACT

2 relating to electric utility weather emergency preparedness.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 38.075(e), Utilities Code, is amended to 5 read as follows:

6 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subtitle, the commission shall allow a transmission and distribution utility 7 8 to design and operate а load management program for [nonresidential] customers to be used where the independent 9 organization certified under Section 39.151 for the ERCOT power 10 region has declared a Level 2 Emergency or a higher level of 11 12 emergency or has otherwise directed the transmission and 13 distribution utility to shed load. A transmission and distribution 14 utility implementing a load management program under this 15 subsection shall be permitted to recover the reasonable and necessary costs of the load management program under Chapter 36. A 16 17 load management program operated under this subsection is not considered a competitive service. 18

19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
