5	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 801, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 801.2052 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 801.2052. DISMISSAL OF BASELESS OR UNFOUNDED
8	COMPLAINT. (a) If, before the 180th day after the date the board's
9	official investigation of a complaint is commenced, the board
10	determines in accordance with rules adopted under this section that
11	a complaint filed with the board is baseless or unfounded, the board
12	shall:
13	(1) dismiss the complaint; and
14	(2) include a statement in the record of the complaint
15	that the complaint was dismissed because the complaint was baseless
16	or unfounded.
17	(b) The board shall adopt rules to implement this section
18	and establish criteria for determining that a complaint is baseless
19	or unfounded.
20	SECTION 2. Rules adopted under Section 801.2052,
21	Occupations Code, as added by this Act, may not take effect until
22	September 1, 2025.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
