4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 51, Education Code, is amended by adding
6	Subchapter J to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER J. ESPIONAGE AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY THEFT PREVENTION
8	Sec. 51.501. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
9	(1) "Coordinating board" means the Texas Higher
10	Education Coordinating Board.
11	(2) "Institution of higher education" has the meaning
12	assigned by Section 61.003.
13	Sec. 51.502. DISCLOSURE OF FOREIGN FUNDING. Not later than
14	September 1 of each year, each institution of higher education
15	shall submit to the coordinating board a report on the funding
16	received by the institution from a foreign entity during the
17	preceding academic year.
18	Sec. 51.503. PROHIBITION ON ACCEPTING GIFTS, GRANTS, OR
19	DONATIONS FROM CERTAIN FOREIGN ENTITIES. An institution of higher
20	education may not accept a gift, grant, or donation from the
21	government of China or a company or other entity directly or

indirectly controlled by the government of China.

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- 1 education shall require each researcher at the institution to
- 2 complete training on the prevention of espionage and intellectual

- 4 (b) The training must include instruction on:
- 5 (1) an understanding of the current national security
- 6 risks related to espionage and intellectual property theft;
- 7 (2) the methods used in espionage and intellectual
- 8 property theft;
- 9 (3) the signs of espionage and intellectual property
- 10 theft;
- 11 (4) measures to protect sensitive information and
- 12 intellectual property; and
- 13 (5) procedures for reporting suspected incidents of
- 14 espionage or <u>intellectual property theft</u>.
- 15 (c) The training must be provided in conjunction with any
- 16 other training required for researchers at the institution of
- 17 <u>higher education provided by the institution's information</u>
- 18 security office.
- 19 Sec. 51.505. REPORTING SYSTEM. Each institution of higher
- 20 education shall establish a reporting system for students, faculty,
- 21 and staff to report to the institution suspicious activity that may
- 22 be related to espionage or intellectual property theft.
- Sec. 51.506. RULES. The coordinating board shall adopt
- 24 rules necessary to implement this subchapter.
- SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2024, each public
- 26 institution of higher education shall:
- 27 (1) submit the initial report required under Section

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- 1 51.502, Education Code, as added by this Act; and
- 2 (2) ensure that each researcher at the institution has
- 3 completed the training required by Section 51.504, Education Code,
- 4 as added by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
