A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the prosecution of the criminal offense of failure to 2 3 identify; creating a criminal offense. 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 38.02, Penal Code, is amended by adding 5 Subsections (b-1), (b-2), (d-1), and (f) and amending Subsection 6 7 (c) to read as follows: 8 (b-1) A person commits an offense if the person: (1) is an operator of a motor vehicle, as defined by 9 10 Section 32.34, who is lawfully detained by a peace officer for an alleged violation of a law; 11 12 (2) fails to provide or display the person's driver's 13 license on the officer's request for the license; and 14 (3) intentionally refuses to give the person's name, 15 driver's license number, residence address, or date of birth to the peace officer on the officer's request for that information. 16 17 (b-2) For purposes of Subsection (b-1)(3), giving a peace officer a residence address that is different from the address 18 associated with the person's driver's license does not constitute a 19 refusal to give the person's residence address in violation of that 20 provision if the address given to the officer is the person's actual 21 22 residence address. 23 (c) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [Subsections] (d) and 24 (d-1) [and (e)], an offense under this section is:

(1) a Class C misdemeanor if the offense is committed 1 2 under Subsection (a) or (b-1); or (2) a Class B misdemeanor if the offense is committed 3 under Subsection (b). 4 5 (d-1) An offense under Subsection (b-1) is a Class B misdemeanor if it is shown on the trial of the offense that the 6 7 actor gave a false or fictitious name to the peace officer during the commission of the offense. 8 9 (f) Subject to Subsection (e), if conduct that constitutes an offense under Subsection (b-1) also constitutes an offense under 10 any other law, the actor may be prosecuted under that subsection, 11
