## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to contributions to, benefits under, and administration of
- 3 Texas local fire fighters' retirement systems.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 29(b), Texas Local Fire Fighters
- 6 Retirement Act (Article 6243e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (b) A municipality or other political subdivision that has
- 9 employees who are participating members of a retirement system
- 10 shall make contributions to the system each payroll period. Except
- 11 as provided by Subsection (d) of this section, contributions
- 12 required under this subsection are computed on the total
- 13 compensation paid to the employees who are participating members of
- 14 the system. A municipality or other political subdivision is
- 15 required to make contributions under this subsection at the same
- 16 rate paid by employees or 12 percent, whichever is the smaller rate.
- 17 The governing body of a municipality or other political subdivision
- 18 by ordinance or, in accordance with Section 29A of this Act, by
- 19 <u>contract</u> may adopt a rate of employer contributions that is greater
- 20 than the rate required by this subsection.
- 21 SECTION 2. Texas Local Fire Fighters Retirement Act
- 22 (Article 6243e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended by
- 23 adding Section 29A to read as follows:
- Sec. 29A. CONTRACT TO INCREASE EMPLOYER CONTRIBUTIONS AND

- 1 MAKE CERTAIN RELATED SYSTEM MODIFICATIONS. (a) A municipality or
- 2 other political subdivision may contract with the board of trustees
- 3 of a retirement system to adopt a rate of employer contributions
- 4 that is greater than the rate required by Section 29(b) of this Act.
- 5 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a contract entered into
- 6 under this section may include provisions modifying the following
- 7 with respect to a retirement system:
- 8 (1) employee contributions;
- 9 (2) actuarial assumptions, provided the actuarial
- 10 assumptions are approved by an actuary who meets the qualifications
- 11 prescribed by Section 7(c) of this Act; and
- 12 (3) benefits.
- SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 14 section, a contract described by Section 29A, Texas Local Fire
- 15 Fighters Retirement Act (Article 6243e, Vernon's Texas Civil
- 16 Statutes), as added by this Act, that was entered into by a
- 17 municipality or other political subdivision and the board of
- 18 trustees of a retirement system before the effective date of this
- 19 Act is validated as of the date the contract was made or attempted
- 20 to be made.
- 21 (b) This section does not validate:
- 22 (1) an act that, under the law of this state at the
- 23 time the act occurred, was a misdemeanor or felony; or
- 24 (2) a matter that on the effective date of this Act:
- 25 (A) is involved in litigation if the litigation
- 26 ultimately results in the matter being held invalid by a final
- 27 judgment of a court; or

- 1 (B) has been held invalid by a final judgment of a
- 2 court.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
