## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use of certain personal leave by school district

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 21, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 21.416 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 21.416. ELECTION BY TEACHER TO USE UNPAID LEAVE. (a)
- 8 The board of trustees of a school district shall adopt a policy that
- 9 provides a classroom teacher employed by the district the option to
- 10 <u>elect not to take the teacher's paid personal leave concurrently</u>
- 11 with unpaid leave the teacher is entitled to take under the Family
- 12 and Medical Leave Act of 1993 (29 U.S.C. Section 2601 et seq.) for
- 13 an absence due to pregnancy or the birth or adoption of a child.
- 14 (b) A teacher who elects to take unpaid leave under this
- 15 section may not take paid personal leave, except in the case of a
- 16 medical or other emergency, until the 13th week following the date
- 17 the teacher returns from the unpaid leave.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 19 school year.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
