5	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 29.919 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 29.919. GRANT PROGRAM FOR STATE CAPITOL VISITS. (a)
8	From funds appropriated or otherwise available for that purpose,
9	the commissioner shall establish a grant program under which grants
10	are awarded to schools that receive federal funding under Title I,

- 12 6301 et seq.) to provide students an opportunity to visit the State
- 13 Capitol as part of a course, extracurricular activity, or field
- 14 trip.
- 15 (b) The commissioner shall adopt procedures for a school to
- 16 apply for a grant under this section.
- 17 <u>(c)</u> The commissioner may solicit and accept gifts, grants,
- 18 and donations from any public or private source for the purposes of
- 19 this section.
- 20 <u>(d) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 21 establish and administer the grant program for State Capitol visits
- 22 under this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 24 of this Act, the commissioner of education shall adopt rules to

- 1 implement the grant program for State Capitol visits under Section
- 2 29.919, Education Code, as added by this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
