7	SECTION 1. Chapter 322, Government Code, is amended by
8	adding Sections 322.025 and 322.026 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 322.025. REPORT ON FISCAL ACTIONS OF LEGISLATURE. (a)
10	Not later than April 1 of each even-numbered year, or as soon
11	thereafter as practicable, the board shall submit to the
12	legislature and post on the board's Internet website a biennial
13	report on the General Appropriations Act passed and other fiscal
14	actions taken by the current legislature to provide contextual
15	information about the structure, operation, and fiscal condition of
16	the government of this state.
17	(b) The report must include:
18	(1) a summary of the overall fiscal condition of this
19	state before the passage of the General Appropriations Act;
20	(2) an overview of the General Appropriations Act,
21	including an overview of the major revenue sources and funds;
22	(3) an examination of economic indicators for this
23	state and the United States for the state fiscal biennium in which
24	the report is made;

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1	(4) a highlight of legislation passed that may have a									
2	significant fiscal effect on the economy of this state; and									
3	(5) a summary of each function of the government of									
4	this state and a comprehensive description of programs and services									
5	funded by the legislature.									
6	Sec. 322.026. REPORT ON GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS BILL. (a)									
7	The board shall submit to the legislature and post on the board's									
8	Internet website a summary of each version of the general									
9	appropriations bill filed in either house of the legislature during									
10	a legislative session as soon as practicable after it is filed.									
11	(b) The report must include:									
12	(1) an overview of the general appropriations bill;									
13	(2) the amount of appropriations proposed for the next									
14	state fiscal biennium compared to the current state fiscal									
15	biennium, in total and disaggregated by each method of finance for									
16	each article of the general appropriations bill;									
17	(3) highlights of major funding items, significant									
18	policy, or fiscal issues across this state;									
19	(4) significant factors affecting the general									
20	appropriations bill;									
21	(5) an explanation of how the appropriations made for									
22	the current state fiscal biennium have been adjusted for the next									
23	state fiscal biennium;									
24	(6) an overview of the total appropriations in each									
25	article of the general appropriations bill by agency or									
26	institution, including estimated and budgeted expenditures for the									
27	current state fiscal biennium and recommended appropriations for									

1	the next state fiscal biennium;
