5	SECTION 1. Subtitle H, Title 2, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Chapter 171A to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 171A. PROHIBITED REPORT OR DISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN HEALTH
8	INFORMATION
9	Sec. 171A.001. PROHIBITED REPORT OR DISCLOSURE BY HEALTH
10	CARE PROVIDERS. Notwithstanding any other law, a physician or
11	other health care provider who provides health care services to a
12	patient who experienced a miscarriage or obtained an abortion or
13	who the physician or provider suspects may have experienced a
14	miscarriage or obtained an abortion is prohibited from reporting or
15	disclosing that information to a peace officer or law enforcement
16	agency.
17	Sec. 171A.002. ENFORCEMENT. The reporting or disclosure of
18	information prohibited under Section 171A.001 by a physician or
19	other health care provider constitutes a violation of Chapter 181
20	and the physician or provider is subject to enforcement actions
21	under Subchapter E of that chapter, including disciplinary action
22	by the appropriate licensing authority.
23	Sec. 171A.003. RULES. The executive commissioner may adopt
24	rules to implement this chapter.

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1 SECTION 2. Chapter 171A, Health and Safety Code, as added by 2 this Act, applies only to the report or disclosure of information 3 described by that chapter that occurs on or after the effective date 4 of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
