A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to allowing parents and guardians to elect for a student to 3 repeat or retake a course or grade. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 28.02124, Education Code, is amended by 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and (a-2) to 6 read as follows: 7 Subject to Subsection (c), a parent or guardian may 8 (a) elect for a student to: 9 repeat prekindergarten; 10 enroll in prekindergarten, if the student would 11 (2) have been eligible to enroll in prekindergarten during the previous 12 school year under Section 29.153(b) and the student has not yet 13 enrolled in kindergarten; 14 15 (3) repeat kindergarten; enroll in kindergarten, if the student would have 16 (4)been eligible to enroll in kindergarten in the previous school year 17 and has not yet enrolled in first grade; or 18 (5) for grades one through eight [three], repeat the 19 grade in which the student was enrolled during the previous school 20 year. 21 22 (a-1) Subject to Subsection (c), for courses taken for high 23 school credit, a parent or guardian may elect for a student to repeat any course in which the student was enrolled in during the 24

previous school year. A parent or guardian may not elect for a 1 student to repeat a course under this subsection if the school 2 district or open-enrollment charter school determines the student 3 4 has met all of the requirements for graduation. (a-2) A parent or guardian may make an election under 5 6 Subsection (a)(5) or (a-1), or both. 7 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024 8 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2023. 13
