A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- relating to the regulation of elevator mechanics, elevator 2
- 3 apprentices, and contractors; requiring an occupational
- registration. 4

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 754.011, Health and Safety Code, is
- 7 amended by amending Subdivision (13) and adding Subdivisions (14-a)
- and (14-b) to read as follows: 8
- (13) "Contractor" means a person engaged in the 9
- business of installation, alteration, testing, repair, 10
- maintenance of equipment. The term does not include an employee of a 11
- 12 contractor or a person engaged in cleaning or any other work
- performed on equipment that does not affect the operational safety 13
- of the equipment or diminish the safety of the equipment below the 14
- level required by the ASME Code A17.1, ASME Code A17.3, ASME Code 15
- 16 A18.1, or ASCE Code 21, as applicable.
- (14-a) "Elevator apprentice" means an individual who 17
- assists an elevator mechanic or contractor in erecting, 18
- constructing, installing, altering, servicing, repairing, or 19
- maintaining equipment. 20
- 21 (14-b) <u>"Elevator mechanic" means an individual who is</u>
- engaged in erecting, constructing, installing, altering, 22
- 23 servicing, repairing, or maintaining equipment.
- 24 SECTION 2. Section 754.015(a), Health and Safety Code, is

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) The commission by rule shall provide for:
- 3 (1) an annual inspection and certification of the
- 4 equipment covered by standards adopted under this chapter;
- 5 (2) enforcement of those standards;
- 6 (3) registration, including certification, of
- 7 elevator inspectors, elevator mechanics, and elevator apprentices;
- 8 (4) registration of contractors;
- 9 (5) the procedures by which a certificate of
- 10 compliance is issued and displayed;
- 11 (6) notification to building owners, architects, and
- 12 other building industry professionals regarding the necessity of
- 13 annually inspecting equipment;
- 14 (7) approval of continuing education programs for
- 15 registered elevator inspectors;
- 16 (8) standards of conduct for individuals who are
- 17 registered under this chapter;
- 18 (9) general liability insurance written by an insurer
- 19 authorized to engage in the business of insurance in this state or
- 20 an eligible surplus lines insurer, as defined by Section 981.002,
- 21 Insurance Code, as a condition of contractor registration with
- 22 coverage of not less than:
- 23 (A) \$1 million for each single occurrence of
- 24 bodily injury or death; and
- 25 (B) \$500,000 for each single occurrence of
- 26 property damage;
- 27 (10) the submission and review of plans for the

- 1 installation or alteration of equipment;
- 2 (11) continuing education requirements for renewal of
- 3 contractor registration;
- 4 (12) maintenance control programs, maintenance,
- 5 repair, and parts manuals, and product-specific inspection,
- 6 testing, and maintenance procedures;
- 7 (13) the method and manner of reporting accidents and
- 8 reportable conditions to the department; and
- 9 (14) an owner's designation of an agent for purposes of
- 10 this chapter.
- 11 SECTION 3. Chapter 754, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 12 by adding Sections 754.0165 and 754.0166 to read as follows:
- Sec. 754.0165. ELEVATOR MECHANIC REGISTRATION. (a) An
- 14 individual may not erect, construct, install, alter, service,
- 15 repair, or maintain equipment unless the individual is:
- 16 (1) registered as an elevator mechanic with the
- 17 department as required by this section; or
- 18 (2) employed by a contractor registered under this
- 19 chapter and supervised by a registered elevator mechanic.
- 20 (b) An applicant for elevator mechanic registration or
- 21 registration renewal shall submit an application to the department
- 22 <u>in the form and manner the department prescribes.</u>
- 23 <u>(c) An applicant for a registration must submit with the</u>
- 24 application:
- 25 (1) a certificate of completion or proof of a
- 26 certificate of completion from:
- 27 (A) a nationally recognized training program for

- 1 the elevator industry;
- 2 (B) an elevator constructor apprenticeship
- 3 program approved by the United States Department of Labor or a
- 4 similar federal program for other equipment; or
- 5 (C) an equivalent program acceptable to the
- 6 department; or
- 7 (2) verifiable evidence in the form and manner the
- 8 department prescribes that the applicant has at least five years of
- 9 experience erecting, constructing, installing, altering,
- 10 servicing, repairing, or maintaining equipment.
- 11 (d) An applicant for registration renewal must submit with
- 12 the application proof of completion of continuing education related
- 13 to the erection, construction, installation, alteration,
- 14 servicing, repair, or maintenance of equipment in accordance with
- 15 commission rule.
- 16 (e) The commission shall adopt rules on issuance of a
- 17 limited elevator mechanic registration, including rules:
- 18 (1) on the qualifications required for the limited
- 19 elevator mechanic registration; and
- 20 (2) to restrict the scope and location of practice of
- 21 <u>an elevator mechanic who receives a limited elevator mechanic</u>
- 22 <u>registration</u>.
- 23 <u>(f) A registration issued under this section expires on the</u>
- 24 first anniversary of the date of issuance.
- Sec. 754.0166. ELEVATOR APPRENTICE REGISTRATION. (a) An
- 26 individual may not assist an elevator mechanic or contractor in
- 27 erecting, constructing, installing, altering, servicing,

- 1 repairing, or maintaining equipment unless the individual is:
- 2 (1) registered as an elevator apprentice as required
- 3 by this section; or
- 4 (2) employed by a contractor registered under this
- 5 chapter and supervised by a registered elevator mechanic.
- 6 (b) An applicant for elevator apprentice registration or
- 7 registration renewal shall submit an application to the department
- 8 in the form and manner the department prescribes.
- 9 (c) An applicant for registration renewal must submit with
- 10 the application proof of completion of continuing education related
- 11 to the erection, construction, installation, alteration,
- 12 servicing, repair, or maintenance of equipment in accordance with
- 13 commission rule.
- 14 (d) A registration issued under this section expires on the
- 15 first anniversary of the date of issuance.
- SECTION 4. Section 754.0171(a), Health and Safety Code, is
- 17 amended to read as follows:
- 18 (a) A person may not be engaged in the business of
- 19 installing, altering, testing, repairing, or maintaining [install,
- 20 repair, alter, test, or maintain] equipment unless the person
- 21 <u>registers</u> [without registering] as a contractor with the department
- 22 as required by this chapter.
- SECTION 5. Chapter 754, Health and Safety Code, is amended
- 24 by adding Section 754.01715 to read as follows:
- Sec. 754.01715. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITIES. A contractor
- 26 may not employ, contract with, or obtain the services of a person to
- 27 install, alter, test, repair, or maintain equipment on the

- 1 contractor's behalf unless the person is registered as an elevator
- 2 mechanic or elevator apprentice under this chapter.
- 3 SECTION 6. Section 754.021, Health and Safety Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 754.021. LIST OF REGISTERED ELEVATOR INSPECTORS,
- 6 ELEVATOR MECHANICS, ELEVATOR APPRENTICES, AND CONTRACTORS;
- 7 PERSONNEL. The executive director shall:
- 8 (1) compile a list of elevator inspectors, elevator
- 9 mechanics, elevator apprentices, and contractors who are
- 10 registered with the department; and
- 11 (2) employ personnel who are necessary to enforce this
- 12 chapter.
- 13 SECTION 7. (a) The Texas Commission of Licensing and
- 14 Regulation shall adopt rules necessary to implement the changes in
- 15 law made by this Act not later than March 31, 2024.
- 16 (b) Notwithstanding Section 754.0165 or 754.0166, Health
- 17 and Safety Code, as added by this Act, an individual is not required
- 18 to comply with those sections until November 1, 2024.
- 19 SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 an application or renewal application for registration as a
- 21 contractor under Chapter 754, Health and Safety Code, as amended by
- 22 this Act, filed on or after November 1, 2024. An application or
- 23 renewal application for registration as a contractor under that
- 24 chapter filed before November 1, 2024, is governed by the law in
- 25 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 26 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 9. An individual who has engaged in the practice of

- 1 erecting, constructing, installing, altering, servicing,
- 2 repairing, or maintaining equipment as defined by Section 754.011,
- 3 Health and Safety Code, in this state for at least five years
- 4 preceding the effective date of this Act is entitled to obtain a
- 5 registration under Section 754.0165, Health and Safety Code, as
- 6 added by this Act, if before September 1, 2024, the person:
- 7 (1) submits an application in the form and manner the
- 8 Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation prescribes; and
- 9 (2) pays the required registration fee.
- 10 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
