4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 39, Utilities Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 39.1591 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 39.1591. BACKUP RELIABILITY SERVICE FOR
8	NON-DISPATCHABLE GENERATION. (a) For the purposes of this
9	section, a generation facility is considered to be non-dispatchable
10	if the facility's generation output is controlled primarily by
11	forces outside of human control.
12	(b) Each non-dispatchable wholesale generation resource in
13	the ERCOT power region shall pay a charge for reliability backup
14	service during each interval the non-dispatchable wholesale
15	generation resource is not available to meet system needs as
16	scheduled. The charge must be paid to dispatchable thermal
17	resources providing energy or ancillary services during the
18	intervals when the reliability backup service is required.
19	(c) The commission shall:
20	(1) establish the charge for reliability backup
21	service in an amount necessary to fully compensate dispatchable
22	thermal resources for providing reliability backup service to
23	improve and maintain the reliability of the grid; and
24	(2) direct the ERCOT independent system operator to

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1 settle the charge for reliability backup service pers	iodically.
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2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
