- 20 this Act, applies only to a cause of action that accrues on or after
- 21 the effective date of this Act. A cause of action that accrued
- 22 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 23 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 24 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
