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1 an on-site manager of an apartment complex; (7) 2 (8) an owner or the owner's employee who leases the owner's improved or unimproved real estate; [or] 3 a transaction involving: 4 (9) 5 (A) the sale, lease, or transfer of a mineral or mining interest in real property; 6 7 (B) the sale, lease, or transfer of a cemetery lot; 8 9 (C) the lease or management of a hotel or motel; 10 or 11 (D) the sale of real property under a power of sale conferred by a deed of trust or other contract lien; 12 13 (10) the purchase, sale, or lease of real property for 14 a limited partnership by: 15 (A) a general partner of the limited partnership; 16 (B) an employee of a general partner of the 17 limited partnership who negotiates the transaction in the course of 18 employment; or 19 (C) an employee of the limited partnership who negotiates the transaction in the course of employment; or 20 21 (11) the purchase, sale, or lease of real property for a limited liability company by: 22 (A) a manager or managing member of the limited 23 24 liability company; 25 (B) an employee of a manager or managing member of the limited liability company who negotiates the transaction in 26 27 the course of employment; or

S.B. No. 1712 (C) an employee or member of the limited liability company who negotiates the transaction in the course of employment. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
