## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the confidentiality of the identity of a public school
- 3 employee who reports a potential threat to the school's threat
- 4 assessment and safe and supportive school team.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.115(c), Education Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:
- 8 (c) The board of trustees of each school district shall
- 9 establish a threat assessment and safe and supportive school team
- 10 to serve at each campus of the district and shall adopt policies and
- 11 procedures for the teams. The team is responsible for developing
- 12 and implementing the safe and supportive school program under
- 13 Subsection (b) at the district campus served by the team. The
- 14 policies and procedures adopted under this section must:
- 15 (1) be consistent with the model policies and
- 16 procedures developed by the Texas School Safety Center;
- 17 (2) require each team to complete training provided by
- 18 the Texas School Safety Center or a regional education service
- 19 center regarding evidence-based threat assessment programs; [and]
- 20 (3) require each team established under this section
- 21 to report the information required under Subsection (k) regarding
- 22 the team's activities to the agency; and
- 23 (4) provide for:
- 24 (A) a district employee who reports a potential

- 1 threat to a team to elect for the employee's identity to be
- 2 confidential and not subject to disclosure under Chapter 552,
- 3 Government Code, except as necessary for the team, the district, or
- 4 law enforcement to investigate the potential threat; and
- 5 (B) the district to maintain a record of the
- 6 identity of a district employee who elects for the employee's
- 7 identity to be confidential under Paragraph (A).
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2023-2024
- 9 school year.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
