## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	Relating to gun safety; creating an offense; increasing a criminal

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Penal Code, is amended by adding new
6	Sections 46.16, 46.17, and 46.18 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 46.16. UNLAWFUL GUN STORAGE. (a) It is an offense for
8	a person to store a firearm, whether loaded or unloaded, or firearm
9	ammunition, in a motor vehicle or boat while the person is not in
10	the motor vehicle or watercraft unless the firearm or firearm
11	ammunition is kept from ordinary observation and locked within the
12	trunk, utility or glove box, or a locked container securely affixed
13	to the motor vehicle or boat.
14	(b) As used in this subsection (a):
15	(1) "watercraft" has the same meaning as defined in
16	Section 46.02 (a-3); (
17	(2) "trunk" means the fully enclosed and locked main
18	storage compartment of a motor vehicle that is not accessible from
19	the passenger compartment, but does not include any compartment
20	that has a window, the bed of a pickup truck, or the rear area of a
21	hatchback, station wagon-type motor vehicle, or sport utility motor
22	vehicle.
23	(c) A violation of this subsection (a) is a Class C
24	misdemeanor punishable only by the completion of a court-approved

1 firearm safety course. 2 Sec. 46.17. REPORT OF GUN THEFT. (a) A person who owns a 3 firearm shall report the loss or theft of the firearm to a law enforcement agency with jurisdiction over the location where the 4 firearm was lost or stolen within twenty-four hours of the 5 discovery of the loss or theft. 6 7 (b) A violation of this section is a Class C misdemeanor punishable only by the completion of a court-approved firearm 8 9 safety course. 10 Sec. 46.18. REQUIRED SIGNAGE FOR GUN DEALERS. (a) A dealer 11 of firearms shall post in a conspicuous position on the premises where the dealer conducts business a sign that contains the 12 13 following warning in block letters not less than one inch in height: "WARNING: Access to a weapon or firearm in the home 14 15 significantly increases the risk of suicide, homicide, death during 16 domestic disputes and unintentional deaths to children, household members, and others. If you or loved one is experiencing distress 17 and/or depression, call the National Suicide Hotline at 988." 18 (b) A dealer of firearms shall post in a conspicuous 19 20 position on the premises where the dealer conducts business a sign that contains the following in block letters not less than one inch 21 in height: 22 "The sale, storage, use of firearm safety equipment is tax 23 free. This includes, a gun lock box, gun safe, barrel lock, trigger 24 25 lock, firearm safety training manual or electronic publication, or 26 other item designed to ensure safe handling or storage of a 27 firearm."

SECTION 2. Chapter 411, Government Code, is amended by adding new Subchapter L-3 to read as follows:

3 SUBCHAPTER L-3. TEXAS FIREARM SAFETY WARNINGS Sec. 411.3801. DEVELOPMENT AND IMPLEMENTATION OF WARNING 4 With the cooperation of the Texas Department 5 SYSTEM. of Transportation, the office of the governor, and other appropriate 6 7 law enforcement agencies in this state, the department shall develop and implement a firearm safety system to be activated at 8 9 regular intervals to publicize firearm safety and storage policies 10 and advice. SECTION 3. Chapter 161, Health and Safety Code, is amended 11 by adding new Section 161.045 to read as follows: 12 Sec. 161.045. REQUIRED GUN SAFETY INFORMATION. A physician 13 facility shall provide to every patient firearm safety and firearm 14 15 storage information. 16 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 19

20 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 21 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 22 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 23 before that date.

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SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

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
