- 14 SECTION 3. Chapter 431, Transportation Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subchapter D-1 to read as follows:
- 16 SUBCHAPTER D-1. ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY CERTAIN LOCAL GOVERNMENT
- 17 CORPORATIONS CREATED BY MUNICIPALITIES OR COUNTIES
- Sec. 431.120. APPLICABILITY OF SUBCHAPTER. This subchapter
- 19 applies to a local government corporation created by a municipality
- 20 or county that has entered into an agreement with a municipality or
- 21 county for the transfer of property tax revenue from the
- 22 <u>municipality or county to the corporation for a specific project.</u>
- Sec. 431.121. BOND ELECTION REQUIRED. (a) A local
- 24 government corporation may not issue bonds to be paid wholly or

- 1 partly from ad valorem taxes approved by the voters of a
- 2 municipality or county under Section 26.07, Tax Code, to pay for a
- 3 specific project, unless the issuance is first approved by the
- 4 voters of the municipality or county in an election.
- 5 (b) An election held for purposes of this section must be
- 6 conducted as provided by Section 1251.003, Government Code.
- 7 (c) At an election ordered on the issuance of bonds under
- 8 this section, the governing body of the municipality or county
- 9 shall also submit the question of whether to impose a tax on
- 10 property in the municipality or county to pay interest on the bonds
- 11 and to provide a sinking fund to redeem the bonds.
- 12 Sec. 431.122. FORM OF BALLOT. (a) The ballot proposition
- 13 for a measure seeking voter approval for issuance of bonds under
- 14 this subchapter must include:
- 15 (1) a plain language description of the single
- 16 specific purposes for which the bonds are to be authorized;
- 17 (2) the total principal amount of the bonds to be
- 18 authorized; and
- 19 (3) that the principal of and interest on the bonds
- 20 will be wholly or partly paid from property tax revenue.
- 21 (b) Each single specific purpose for which bonds requiring
- 22 voter approval are to be issued must be printed on the ballot as a
- 23 separate proposition. A proposition may include as a specific
- 24 purpose one or more structures or improvements serving the
- 25 substantially same purpose and may include related improvements and
- 26 equipment necessary to accomplish the specific purpose.
- 27 SECTION 4. The change in law made by Subchapter D-1, Chapter

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- 1 431, Transportation Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a
- 2 bond authorized to be issued on or after the effective date of this
- 3 Act.
- 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
