1 AN ACT relating to a requirement that each appraisal district periodically 2 3 confirm that recipients of residence homestead exemptions qualify 4 for those exemptions. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.43, Tax Code, is amended by adding 6 Subsection (h-1) to read as follows: 7 8 (h-1) The chief appraiser of an appraisal district shall develop a program for the periodic review of each residence 9 10 homestead exemption granted by the district under Section 11.13 to confirm that the recipient of the exemption still qualifies for the 11 12 exemption. The program must require the chief appraiser to review each residence homestead exemption at least once every five tax 13 years. The program may provide for the review to take place in 14 phases, with a portion of the exemptions reviewed in each tax year. 15 SECTION 2. The chief appraiser of an appraisal district 16 17 shall develop and implement the program required by Section 11.43(h-1), Tax Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 18 1, 2024. The program must provide that the first five-year review 19
