(d) An advisory council member appointed under Subsection 23 24 (a)(2) or (3) may designate another individual to serve in the member's place on the advisory council at the pleasure of the 25 26 member. 5 Sec. 119A.005. CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR. Members of the 6 advisory council shall elect from among <u>its</u> [the legislative] 7 members <u>by a majority vote</u> [of the advisory council] a chair and 8 vice chair.
