## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the eligibility of a person to serve on the appraisal
- 3 review board of certain appraisal districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 6.412, Tax Code, is amended by amending
- 6 Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) A person is ineligible to serve on the appraisal review
- 8 board of an appraisal district established for a county with a
- 9 population of 120,000 or more if the person:
- 10 (1) is a former member of the board of directors,
- 11 former officer, or former employee of the appraisal district;
- 12 (2) served as a member of the governing body or officer
- 13 of a taxing unit for which the appraisal district appraises
- 14 property, until the fourth anniversary of the date the person
- 15 ceased to be a member or officer; or
- 16 (3) appeared before the appraisal review board for
- 17 compensation during the two-year period preceding the date the
- 18 person is appointed[; or
- 19 [(4) served for all or part of three previous terms as
- 20 a board member or auxiliary board member on the appraisal review
- 21 board].
- (e) A person who has served for all or part of three
- 23 consecutive terms as a board member or auxiliary board member on the
- 24 appraisal review board of an appraisal district established for a

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- 1 county with a population of 120,000 or more is ineligible to serve
- 2 on the appraisal review board during a term that begins on the next
- 3 January 1 following the third of those consecutive terms.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
