AN ACT
relating to prohibiting the acquisition or use of certain unmanned
aircraft by a governmental entity.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. The heading to Chapter 423, Government Code, is
amended to read as follows:
CHAPTER 423. [USE OF] UNMANNED AIRCRAFT
SECTION 2. Chapter 423, Government Code, is amended by
adding Section 423.010 to read as follows:
Sec. 423.010. ACQUISITION OR USE OF CERTAIN FOREIGN
UNMANNED AIRCRAFT BY GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY PROHIBITED. (a) In this
section:
(1) "Company" means a sole proprietorship,
organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint
venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or
limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary,
majority-owned subsidiary, parent company, or affiliate of those
entities or business associations, that exists to make a profit.
(2) "Governmental entity" means this state, a
political subdivision of this state, or an agency of this state or a
political subdivision of this state.

(b) A governmental entity may not acquire or use an unmanned

- 21 (d-1) The Model Security Plan for Prohibited Technologies
- 22 <u>described in Subsection (d) shall include, without limitation,</u>
- 23 companies listed in Section 889 of the federal National Defense
- 24 <u>Authorization Act.</u>
- 25 (d-2) The Model Security Plan for Prohibited Technologies
- 26 <u>described in Subsection (d) shall include companies who are</u>
- 27 excluded by future Acts of Congress, or federal administrative

- 2 (d-3) The Model Security Plan for Prohibited Technologies
- 3 described in Subsection (d) shall include any other companies The
- 4 Department of Information Resources deems unsuitable for use by a
- 5 public agency.
- 6 SECTION 3. Section 423.010, Government Code, as added by
- 7 this Act:
- 8 (1) applies to the acquisition of unmanned aircraft or
- 9 any related services or equipment on or after the effective date of
- 10 this Act, except that a contract or agreement to purchase or
- 11 otherwise acquire an unmanned aircraft or related services or
- 12 equipment described by that section that is entered into before the
- 13 effective date of this Act is unaffected by this Act;
- 14 (2) applies to the use of an unmanned aircraft or any
- 15 related services or equipment two years after the effective date of
- 16 this Act, regardless of whether the unmanned aircraft or any
- 17 related services or equipment were acquired before, on, or after
- 18 the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
